Birds may be penned Saturday afternoon/night. Please let the secretary know if you will require access during this time, to ensure the pavilion will be open.

The committee of the Queensland Pit Game Fowl Club Inc. wish to express their sincere thanks to all donors, both individuals and groups who have so generously chosen to support our club. Without this support the club would not possibly be able to stage such an event, which allows members, friends and fanciers to meet and enjoy fellowship while admiring the true magistry of the true "King of the Fowls."



Please contact Stephen Kavanagh in writing or by phone with your nominations for election of offices & judges for the 2014 titles, as well as any other item you wish to have added to the AGM agenda. These are required no later than the 17th of August 2013. Remember you must have all nominations in by the 17th August to ensure inclusion on the agenda, if it is not on the agenda it will not be dealt with at the AGM.

Conditions of show

1. For the purpose of this show, the following terminology will apply:
 - a) PIT GAME refer to birds of NORMAL feathering b) HENFEATHER refer to birds predominantly HENFEATHERED.
 2. All exhibits shall be penned by 8.30am on the show date and are not to be removed until judging is final and presentation of awards is concluded.
 3. Exhibitors must hold a current FCAQI Certificate, the number of which is to be quoted on the entry form. Certificates may be purchased on the day, but prior to penning. Certificates will be available from the secretary prior to show day.
 4. Once judging has commenced no exhibitor may interfere or remove an exhibit from a pen without the consent of the Chief Steward.
 5. Sections of the pavilion will be roped off from exhibitors while the section in question is being judged.
 6. The Club will not, under any circumstances, hold itself responsible for any loss, misdelivery or damage to exhibits.
 7. Waters will be provided in all pens by the club, but the filling of them remains the responsibility of the exhibits owner. The club will not be held responsible for any unwatered bird's on the day.
 8. Birds in single classes are only eligible for those awards.
 9. Birds over twelve (12) months will judged as adults.
 10. Any person found removing eggs from the exhibit pens will be prosecuted unless given permission by the Chief Steward.
 11. No leg bands on poultry allowed.
 12. No entries will be accepted on the day of the show. ENTRIES MUST BE SUBMITTED BEFORE CLOSING DATE (10TH JULY 2013) AND ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES.
 13. Should any dispute for which there is no specific rule arise, the matter in dispute shall be referred to the Club Committee, the decision of which is final.
 14. All major champions and reserve birds that are in contention for pit of show and reserve will be placed in the champion pens out front before they are awarded.
- 15. Decisions made by the elected judges are final.**
16. The Committee reserves the right to amend the Schedule if necessary.
 17. All birds exhibited are to be the bonafied property of the exhibitor.
 18. Birds exhibited are to be free of vermin and disease or entries will automatically be removed from pens at the direction of the Chief Steward.
 19. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entries, the decision of which is final.
 20. To be eligible for Member's entry fee, the membership fee must also be included with total fees.
 21. Junior Exhibitors, this is a separate section within the overall show. Juniors compete against other Juniors and exhibits in this section are ineligible for open class awards.
 22. 20. Junior exhibitors to be 16 years and under and over 4 years of age.
 23. 21. Exhibit must be penned by the Junior to which it belongs.
 24. 22. A Junior exhibitor must own and have in their possession their entries for a period of six months prior to the show, the above conditions will be enforced by the committee.
 25. If a Junior chooses to exhibit a fowl in the open class, that exhibit then becomes ineligible for awards on offer in the Junior section.
 26. Pens will be available for anyone wishing to sell birds, at their own discretion. Limit of 3 birds per pen, \$5 per pen (to be paid with entries). QPGFC takes no responsibility for sale of birds & payment (name & price to be placed on pens by vendor).
 27. If an exhibitor wishes to protest on a ruling it will cost the exhibitor protesting \$50 non refundable for an enquiry to occur by the committee.
 28. Birds shall not be moved from the Pavilion until the show is deemed complete or permission is granted by the Chief Stewart. Failure to do so will result in the forfeiting of all winnings attained during the show. Those winnings will then remain the property of the Qld Pit Game Fowl Club Inc.
